


Adventures in Architecture Summer Day Camp

Students from 8 to 13 with an interest in design and construction attended IAF's first Adventures in Architecture summer day camp at the Des Moines Social Club.

The camp was a collaboration between IAF and the Des Moines Social Club, and was made possible by funding from Terracon Foundation. It was led by AIA Associates Holly Pohlmeier and Eli Goll (Both with OPN Architects), who were assisted by high school students from the ACE Mentor program.

Campers engaged in the design process, visited architecture and engineering offices, visited a job site and went on a Downtown Des Moines walking tour to scout out architectural elements. Their teams created an Olympic Village and presented their projects on the last day of class. Through Adventures in Architecture camp, students applied academic concepts to real world situations. They gained a deeper understanding and appreciation of their own communities and the wider world. Three students were given free tuition scholarships to attend the camp.





Mid Century Modern Tour Held Showcasing Homes in Oskaoosa

This unique tour featured four remarkable homes, including the Jack Lamberson home designed by Frank Lloyd Wright. The tour was made possible by Mid Mod Iowa and IAF volunteers, as well as the gracious homeowners who welcomed the tour goers: Peter and Irma Maunu, Emily Russell, Kim and Marv Bloem, Christine Goertz and Randy Degeest. Mid Mod Iowa generously donated the proceeds to IAF so we can offer similar programs in the future to inspire an appreciation of architecture and design. IAF Mid-Century Modern Landscape Design Lecture and Book Signing With Ethne Clarke

IAF and Greater Des Moines Botanical Gardens paired up on a lecture and book signing by renowned garden author, Ethne Clarke on April 29. Ms. Clarke, is an award-winning journalist and former editor of Traditional Home and contributing editor for House & Garden. Well known as the author of a number of best-selling books, in her talk she explored the origins of Mid-Century Modern garden design, revealing how architects like Frank Lloyd Wright and Cliff May worked with landscape architects to blur the divisions between indoors and outdoors.













Architectural Tours in Downtown Des Moines


Demand for IAF custom tours increased in 2018. Walking tours of downtown Des Moines were offered to Drake University's International Program, BSB Design, Iowa Natural Heritage Foundation, Design Build Institute of America (DBIA), Greater Des Moines Leadership Institute, Lillis O'Malley Olson Law Firm, Des Moines Area Leadership Group, Wine Flights (part of Des Moines Winefest), Grinnell College and YPC. A motor coach tour for the spouses of the World Food Prize Laureates took participants to the Greater Des Moines Botanical Garden and the Des Moines Art Center, as well as the Mid-Century Modern 601 Grand and AEG headquarters. IAF volunteer guides - mainly architects - lead the tours and the fees go to keep the foundation running.

The tours generally follow four routes, covering East, South, North and West. In 2018 two extra tours were added in October, called the Western Edition. The special tours included Western Gateway Park, its planning and evolution, and key buildings in the area, such as Krause Gateway Center and The Temple for the Performing Arts and the history of the buildings along Locust Street that comprised "Auto Row," including Herring Motor Car, Kruidenier Cadillac, Studebaker Corporation Branch Office, as well as many other buildings in the area.









Architectural Classes

Chicago's World Class Architecture: This class introduced participants to Chicago's rich architectural heritage, covering historic, mid-century, and current periods and their architects.

Des Moines and The City Beautiful Movement

This class focused on the movement at the turn of the previous century adopted by Des Moines' leaders – a philosophy that believed creating a beautiful city would inspire the inhabitants toward moral and civic virtue and invigorate the downtown.

What Style is Your House?

Participants learned about residential architecture in Des Moines and how to identify many different styles. The class included a tour of the North of Grand neighborhood to discover what kinds of homes were built there and why.

On June 16, 180 people gathered at 601 Grand to celebrate the restoration of 601 Grand Avenue in Des Moines. The benefit to support IAF's programming featured visual displays of Mies's life and achievements, as well as the building's evolution and the battle by preservationists to save save it. Mayor Frank Cownie, City of Des Moines; Bishop Pates, DSM Catholic Diocese; Tim Leach, GDM Partnership and Jonathan Fletcher, grandson of Home Federal S&L founder, joined architect John Gardner of BBS, and committee members Nick Maletta, Josh Braby and Claudia Cackler, in weighing in on the significance of the building. Iconic classic furnishings were on display for photo opportunities, with music by John Krantz Trio and DJ John Solarz. 


